SUNDRE, NORRLANDA

The Swedish History Museum has two world unique organs from the island of Gotland.

The Sundre and Norrlanda organs.

Sundre was built 1370 of which only the case remains today.

Norrlanda has been studied extensively and retains many original parts. Drawings and replica have been made.

A museum is also known for many interesting artefacts from early scandinavia.

ENGELBREKT CHURCH

This is a fabulous church complex designed by Arkitekt Lars Israel Wahlman 1914.

An organ from 1964 was installed during the organ reform movement period. This instrument is one of Sweden largest mechanical organs and an illustration of how an organ from this period is still relevant. The facade combines traditional and modern elements.

THE ROYAL CASTLE

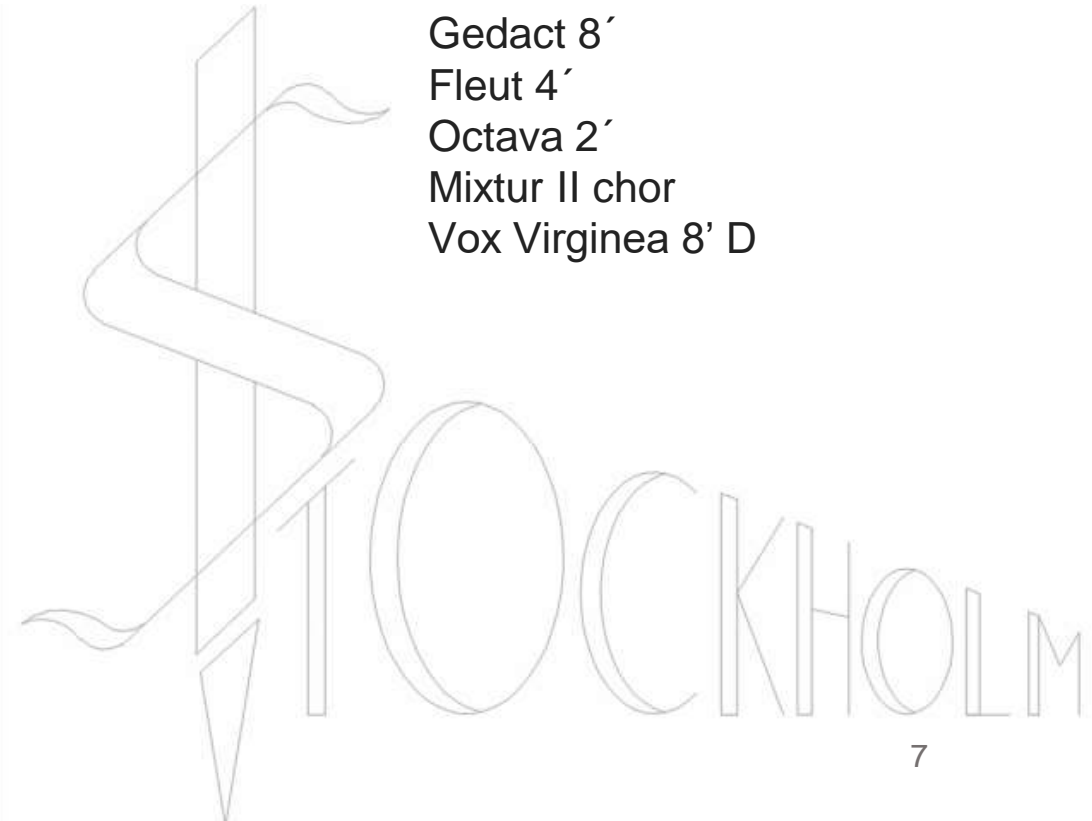
Organ by Jonas Gren and Petter Stråhle 1754.

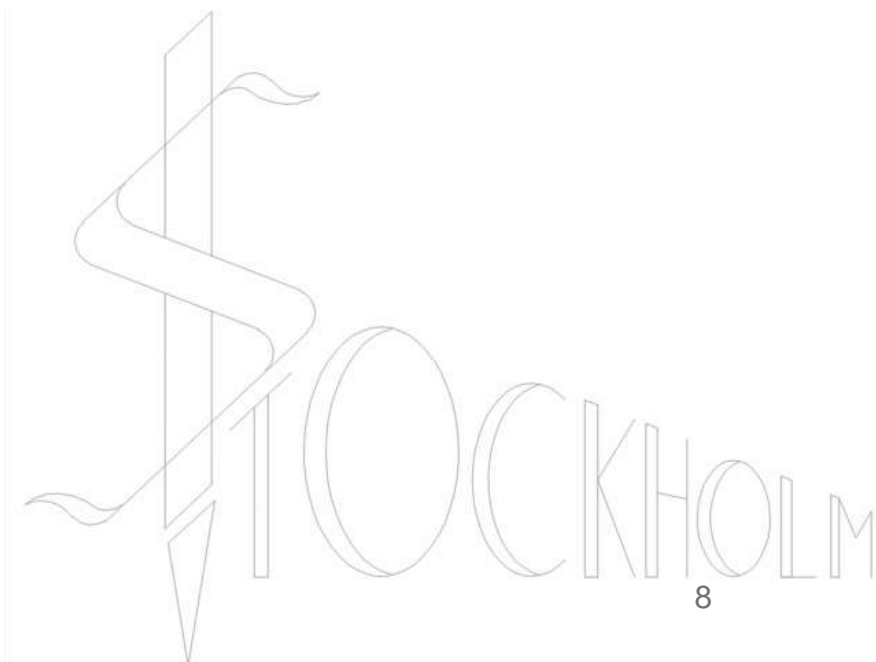

This organ, a Wurlitzer Style E, opus 1254 comes from the Skandia Theatre. It was moved in the hall where the first nuclear reactor was installed. The hole is where the actual reactor stood!

BÄLINGE

1632-1640 organ builders Hermann & Eisenmenger installed an organ in Storkyrkan, Stockholm which was subsequently repaired and altered. In 1788 the positive was removed and installed in Bälinge. Further changes followed in its new location.

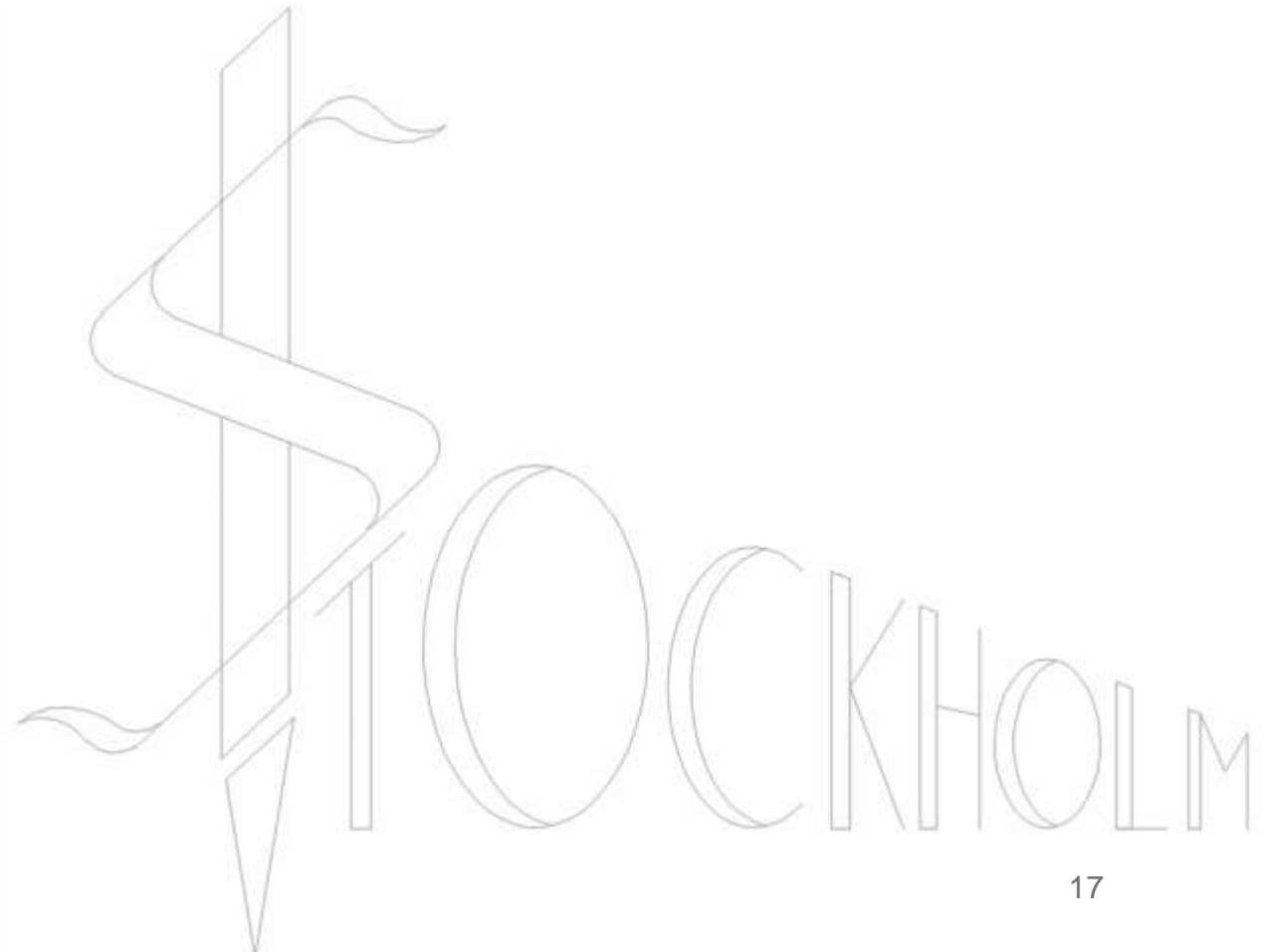
